IAMS INAUGURATED BY CHIEF MINISTER.

Bhubaneswar, 3rd July

In another step towards administrative reforms Chief Minister Sri Naveen Patnaik has inaugurated the Integrated Asset Management System (IAMS) today in the facilitation Center of the Central Record Room of Secretariat. Inaugurating the system Chief Minister told that this web based integrated system would ensure smooth management of residential land within Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation area and bring transparency in the process of land management. Witnessing the utility and applicability of the system through a power point presentation Chief Minister Sri Patnaik congratulated the team who has developed the soft ware. It is of worth mention that the system has been developed by in house technical team Center for Modernizing Government Initiatives (CMGI) Cell of General Administration Department.

Joining the Inaugural Ceremony Chief Secretary Sri Bijay Kumar Patnaik told that the facility will provide expedited services with regard to conversion of lease hold lands to free hold lands outside the secretariat so that people can easily have on line access to necessary data. The facilitation center will also be a contact point for the people outside the secretariat campus so that they can have physical access to the office without going through procedural requirement for entry to Secretariat. Special Secretary G.A. Sri U.N.Behera told that in the first phase land conversion works will be done on line through this system. Later on mutation works will be added to it. The allotment and change of Govt quarters can also be done on line by this system.

The new system will provide for online application for conversion from leasehold to freehold. It will also have the facility of receipt of acknowledgement through SMS. The status of applications can be traced on line. Intimation for deposit of conversion fees can be sent through SMS. A facilitation center has been set up in the Estate Court Building near Central Record Room to facilitate the applicants to apply on line. Support staffs of CMGI have been placed in the facilitation center to provide necessary help to the applicant for filling applications on line. The facilitation centers will operate during office hours on all working days. The center will provide for web camera to catch the live photo of the applicant which will be placed in the space for photograph in the application. After filing the application the applicant will get a unique identification number. The applicant can check the status of his application at any time during official hours in the center. The applicant can also get the printed copy of the approval letter for deposit of conversion fees from this center.
